

MINUTES
REGULAR CALLED CITY COUNCIL MEETING
JULY 13, 2026

The City Council of the City of Jasper, Texas, met on July 13, 2026, with the following members present to wit:

Mayor Clark McLane called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m., and Council Member Lequin Hilderbrand opened it with prayer. All council members were present except Council Member Katelyn Hanson. There were no public comments.

Council Member Bob Mayhar made a motion to approve the consent agenda:

1. Regular Called City Council meeting minutes, June 8, 2026
2. City of Jasper 2nd Quarter Investment Report
3. Ordinance amending and updating Ordinance Chapter 14 Motor Vehicles and Traffic: Article II, Traffic Control Devices

Council Member Daer Kyles seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Council Member Bob Mayhar made a motion to approve the management agreement between the City of Jasper and the Jasper Chamber of Commerce. Council Member Daer Kyles seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Council Member Mamie Horn made a motion to approve the multipurpose pavilion rules and fees. Council Member Bob Mayhar seconded the motion. Discussion was made. The motion passed unanimously.

Council Member Lequin Hilderbrand made a motion to approve the variance request for 917 S. Main St. Council Member Mamie Horn seconded the motion. Inspector Jeremy Chesnutt recommended approval. The motion passed unanimously.

A public hearing was held for 229 N. Bowie St. Mr. Nicholas Webster appealed the requirements to comply with single-family residences. Much discussion was made.

Council Member Bob Mayhar made a motion to table the appeal from Mr. Nicholas Webster at 229 N. Bowie St. to comply with the requirements for a single-family residence. Council Member Daer Kyles seconded the motion. Much discussion was made regarding the appeal. The motion passed unanimously.

Council Member Bob Mayhar made a motion to approve amending and updating the Council Meeting Rules and Procedure to remove "once an agenda item has been decided by the city council with a vote, neither that person nor any person may submit the item or any item concerning a similar subject matter for placement on the agenda for 365 days, one year, unless the item is requested to be placed on a future agenda and approved with a majority vote by the city council to do so, as well as adding the mayor and one council person will exercise his/her best judgement in determining if items received for placement on the agenda meet the criteria. Council Member Lequin Hilderbrand seconded the motion. During discussion Council member Hilderbrand would like the mayor and two council persons to be able to remove an item instead of one. Council member Bob Mayhar amended his motion to include 2 council persons and the mayor to exercise his/her best judgment in determining if items received for placement on the agenda meet the criteria. Council Member Lequin Hilderbrand seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Justin Broughnon from the United States Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) informed the council of the agreement they would like to enter into with the City of Jasper Police Department. Much discussion was made regarding the agreement. Council Member Lequin Hilderbrand made a motion to approve the Memorandum of Agreement between the United States Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) and the Jasper Police Department. Council member Daer Kyles seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

The council then went into executive session at 7:28 pm pursuant to Texas Government Code 551 Section 551.071 Consultation with Attorney: Pending Litigation. The council reconvened at 7:57 pm. Council Member Lequin Hilderbrand made a motion to accept the proposed settlement with Mr. Josh Hadnot. Council Member Bob Mayhar seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

During Council Time Discussion, Council Member Bob Mayhar asked City Manager Greg Kelley to let everyone know about the compliment Inspector Jeremy Chesnutt received from a citizen for helping her with a generator case that started off against state code.

Council Member Bob Mayhar made a motion to adjourn. The motion passed unanimously. The meeting was adjourned at 8:01 pm.
