BASIC PORTABLE/MOBILE UNIT BUILDING/PERMIT REQUIREMENTS

Portable buildings/trailers used for the sale of food, snow cones, etc. That are placed on property located along public streets shall comply with the following requirements.

Portable shall be defined as not being blocked, anchored or having additional attachments such as decks, porches or landings that are not a permanent part of the unit and must be readily moveable (legally) on public streets and highways.

To obtain an inspection the Manufactures Certificate of Title and a Current Department of Public Safety Registration must be presented upon request, and the items below must be completed or in place at the time of the inspection.

1. The unit frame, siding, roof and interior must be new or in like new condition.
2. The unit shall be provided with a hand washing facility in compliance with the 2015 International Plumbing Code and State and County Health Laws.
3. A toilet facility shall be provided on the property and available for the owner and or employees while occupied in compliance with in compliance with the 2015 International Plumbing Code and State and County Health Laws.
4. The unit shall have self-contained water and waste water supply tanks mounted to the unit and capable of providing enough water for cleaning and sanitizing utensils and equipment in compliance with in compliance with the 2015 International Plumbing Code and State and County Health Laws.
5. The water supply tank may be filled by connecting to the City of Jasper water supply through a listed and properly installed Reduced Pressure Backflow Prevention Assembly (RPZA) device in accordance with the City of Jasper Backflow Ordinance. Unit may not be continuously/permanently connected and must be removed prior to opening for sales.
6. Electrical connections shall be allowed when a properly installed RV receptacle and cord is provided in compliance with the current adopted addition of the 2014 National Electrical Code.
7. Extension cords shall not be used for interior or exterior wiring. See 2014 National Electrical Code.
8. The unit shall not be located within 6 feet of a TYPE-VI building nor within 20 feet of a property line facing the public right of way in accordance with City of Jasper minimum setback requirements. See the latest adopted code addition for distances on additional construction types.
9. One 3A40BC certified and wall mounted fire extinguisher must be provided in compliance with the current adopted Fire Prevention Code. Note: Type K required for grease cooking per 2015 International Fire Code
10. An approved drive and parking shall be provided and may not include areas located in the right of way.
11. Tables and chairs for on premise consumption shall not be provided.
12. Portable steps may be used for window access, however, deck and porches shall not be permitted unless it is an integral part of, and a factory installed attachment to the unit.
13. Containers for garbage and refuse shall be available on the premises in compliance with the City of Jasper Solid Waste requirements
14. All wastewater shall be disposed of in accordance with City of Sanitary Sewer Requirements and shall not be permanently attached to the sanitary sewer system.
15. Only single service articles shall be provided for consumer.
18. All persons working with food products must hold a valid County Food Handlers Health Card.
19. Proof of a Health Department permit shall be posted.
20. Proof of a current TAX Certificates shall be provided.
21. Signs shall not be placed in the RIGHT OF WAY and all permits shall be obtained when applicable.
22. A Fire Suppression Vent hood must be installed for cooking equipment using grease/oil, griddles or stoves per IMC-2015. List is not inclusive of all equipment requiring a fire suppression system

All units not in full compliance with the above listed requirement will be considered permanent in nature and must comply with all recently adopted codes and City of Jasper Ordinances.
